As you stand from the front: the left side of the waharoa represents all Iwi, and Te Ao Māori, The right hand side represents all the other nations of the Pacific, Ngā motu o te moana-nui-a-kiwa .English medium is incorporated into the two pou of the waharoa. The middle piece to be attached is the tohu of Te Huringa Rumaki Reo.

Te Ingoa o te Waharoa

Ko Te Uetanga o Te Huringa Rumaki Reo te ingoa o te waharoa.

The re-verberations of Te Huringa Rumaki Reo.

Explanation: When Rangī and Papatuanuku were parted, there was vibration, quaking, and light was able to enter into the world. When you pass under the waharoa, you enter into the māramatanga o ngā matauranga Māori that has been left for those of Te Huringa Rumaki Reo to be guided by. Nga mihi nutunga kore kia koe Matua Tipene Paea.

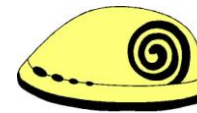

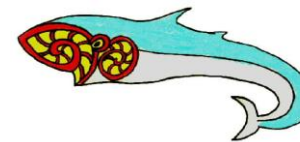
