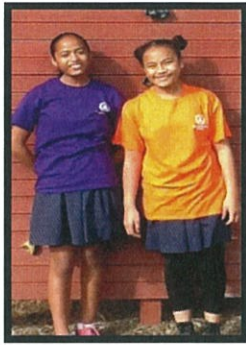

IKALE TAHI VS MANU SAMOA

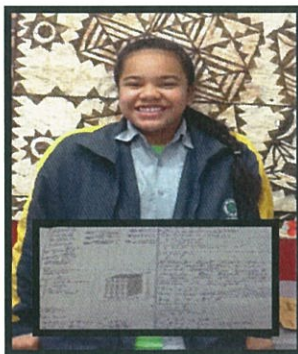
