this is an example of a command in simple passive form

A more literal translation is: Tūwhitia te hopo – eliminate the negative; mairangatia te angitū – accentuate the positive.

We are all in this together / We got this, fam!

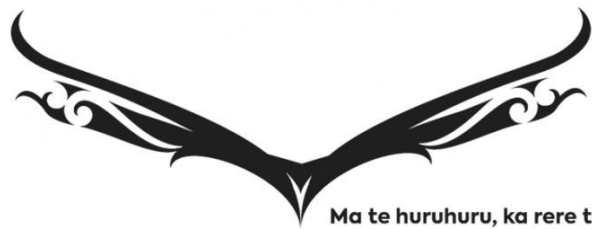
This whakatauki has several meanings, one of which is "a waka we are all in together" – we are all in this together – we rise together, fall together, work together, keep going together.

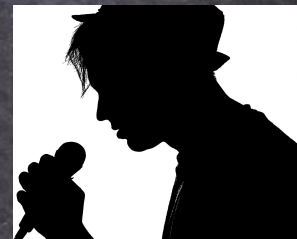
