<u>Health and Well Being</u> Make your bed and tidy your room everyday	<u>Te Reo Maori</u> Teach a whanau member the words to He Waiata Matariki	<u>Art & Math</u> Practise drawing different sized Whetu, tuna, ika, manu, kites, rakau, hua rakau, hua whenua for your art work	<u>Art & Math</u> Draw and colour your own Matariki whaanau	<u>Writing & Reading</u> Draw a picture of what your whanau did on the weekend and write about it
<u>Health & Well Being</u> Help an adult to make lunch or dinner. Lay the table	<u>WRITING & READING</u> Collect 20 blades of grass. Use to form your full name.	<u>Health & Well Being</u> Practise Waewaenuku movements outside for 3 – 5 minutes	<u>Health & Well Being</u> Make up your own dance moves to He Waiata Matariki	<u>Visual & Oral Language</u> Every day, make a card for someone in your whanau and read it to them.
<u>Health & Well Being</u> Race against a sibling or time yourself running up and down the driveway	<u>Health & Well Being</u> Do a handstand for as long as you can counting in Te Reo Maaori	<u>Writing & Reading</u> Tell someone what the word 'predict' means then list all words that start with PRE	<u>Math & Art</u> Think about your dream playground. Draw your design.	<u>Visual & Oral Language</u> Draw a picture of your chosen role model then tell someone why you look up to them
<u>Math</u> Help fold the washing - pair the socks, count how many pairs, how many socks altogether?	<u>Te Reo Maori</u> Every day, watch your favourite Maori TV show. Try to read the subtitles. Listen carefully to the words (kupu). Practice these kupu and use them.	<u>Writing & Reading</u> Find objects around the house from the alphabet. List objects in alphabetical order. Which letters couldn't you find objects for?	<u>Writing & Reading</u> Watch a movie. Draw what happened in the beginning, the middle and the end. Write in words your retell.	<u>Visual, Oral & Written Language</u> Draw a picture of you being 'Kia Aroha', 'Kia Tika', 'Kia Pono', 'Kia Pukumahi'. Then write your story about it explaining what you're doing and how it is helpful
<u>Math</u> Learn how to tie your laces, share with your whanau and show me when you get back to school	<u>Te Reo Maori</u> Ask someone to explain the definition of the word 'kaitiaki'	<u>WRITING & READING</u> Every day practice your; - A,B,C's. A is for apple...Aa, Aa... - Practice spelling 5 new words a day. When you have aced all 5 words. Learn a 'new five'.	<u>Creative Learning</u> Create a tower or fort using all of your toys	<u>Math:</u> Every day practice your; - Counting up to 100 and back from in 1's, 2's, 5's & 10's - adding doubles up to 10 then 20 - adding up to 5, 10, 20 - 12+6=? counting on if you can - times tables 2s and 5s if you can - take away by counting backwards
