

CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

Students are to be expected to treat school property (buildings, playground & sports equipment, furniture, library & textbooks etc) with care and respect.

ICT DEVICES

1. Eating or drinking near your device may cause damage.
2. Lock your classroom to prevent/deter theft.
3. Report ALL stolen or damaged devices to Repairs immediately.
4. Have a good in-class system to check ICT devices daily.
5. Perform regular surface maintenance of devices in order to keep devices in a clean condition.

It is school policy that students accept responsibility for their actions. For wilful damage to or loss of school property it is expected that the child/ren concerned will pay something towards the replacement cost, provide a replacement, or assist in repairing the damage.

CLASSIFICATION AND PROMOTION

Classification into various class levels will be primarily for the purpose of official records. Classes will be of mixed ability.

As a general rule age promotion will apply annually although if it is considered beneficial to a students 'whole' development, he or she will be advanced or retained as the circumstances warrant **after parent consultation**.

The following general policies will apply:

1. Students may be promoted to Y3 if they are 6 years 10 months on 1 January of that year **and achieving at capable levels academically**.
2. A child's classification will be open to review at any time of the year, and will not be confined to the end of the year only.
3. A promotions review list will be kept of children whose classifications are likely to need reconsideration at some appropriate stage in their schooling.
