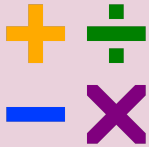


Times Table Corners

Build a blanket fort.

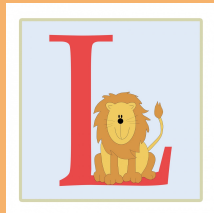
Invite your family members in and eat your lunch inside!
