Term 3, 2020 Update

This is just a short message to let you know that Mana Kidz will continue to provide our full school based health services in Term 3. We will have appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to ensure we provide a safe service. We ask that whānau text or phone their clinic if they are concerned for an unwell child who is not at school.

As we return to our full service, we will also be resuming class checks. These are key as they help us detect students who are at risk of developing Rheumatic Fever (RF). It is important we continue to work and minimise any rise in rheumatic fever.

- Sore throats
- Skin health concerns, like eczema or infections
- Headlice
- Asthma or breathing concerns
- Immunisation support
- Ear and vision health concerns
- Any other health concerns a child may have
