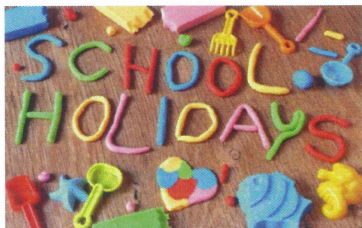

In Term 4, there will be 2 teacher only days. both are for teacher training in the new Digital Technology curriculum and Assessment of students.

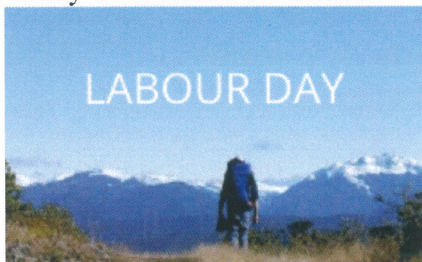
- First Teacher only Day – Tuesday 27 October (After Labour Day).

- Kaiako (teacher) winner – Whaea Breeze (B9)



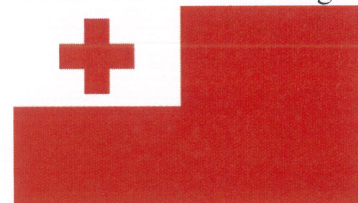
