Dear Parents,

POSITIVE IN THE HOME

If your family has a "positive" test for anyone in your home, the Government/Health ask all members to stay at home even if others are "negative". They ask all to stay isolated for 10 days. Test at Day 8 and if negative children can come back to school on Day 10. These rules may change so keep listening to the News channels on TV.



HOME LEARNING

If your child is not sick, email or contact their Teacher through the school office to provide learning packs or online contact.

School is a safe place for your children. Most positive cases are from a parent's work or in the community.

Please get your children vaccinated, ages 5 onwards. This provides greater protection from serious illness.
