Dear Parents,

With the changes announced by the Government yesterday, we are now in Phase 3.

**Phase 3 means** - "Close Contacts" are only those in a household that has a POSITIVE CASE. All households with a positive case must isolate for 10 days and test at Day 8. (Count your 10 days from the day of your test).

This means that all students from OT8, OT10, TR2, TRS, TR7, TH4, SM2 and SMS can now return to school.

- If your child is COVID19 symptom free send them back to school.
- If your child is sick keep them at home.
- Please let our school know if your child is "positive" or is isolating because a family member is positive. We will set up home learning for your child.

Schools are the safest place for your children. We have many safety processes in place.
